Isaac & an infant at the breast, children of the said Kit, wishes
to have from under my hand an acknowledgment that the said servants
are her property & not mine. Therefore, Know all men by these
presents, that I Margaret Wootton acknowledge that each & all of
the servants above named are the property of my mother, M^{rs} Mary
Hall. Signed this eighth day of May 1860

Of the above named servants, to wit, Betsy and Jerry, Harriet,
Andrew, Rachel & Peter, children of the said Betsy; Sophy and Rose,
Sally and an infant at the breast, children of the said Sophy; Kit and
Bill, Mit. Henry, Isaac and an infant at the breast, children of the
said Kit, now in possession of my daughter Margaret Wootton, I
Mary Hall, in consideration of the trouble & expense of the said Mar-
garet Wootton in feeding & clothing & taking care of the said negroes
for me, and also in consideration of the love & affection I bear her
as my dear & dutiful daughter, do give unto the said Margaret
Wootton, the following servants; to wit, Andrew & Peter, children of
the said Betsy; the infants at the breast of Sophy & Kit & also any
increase of the said Betsy, Sophy & Kit, occurring after this time I
give them, the said servants, to the said Margaret Wootton absolutely
& completely & from this day, they are hers, & the said Mary Hall ha-
ving given her possession of them. If any solemnity of law be wanting
in this transaction which may be requisite to give it effect, I neverthe-
less bind & obligate myself & my heirs, administrators & executors to observe
& respect it, as fully as if every legal requisite had been complied with
